UNMISS “Protection of Civilians” (PoC) Sites Population Update*





As of 26 March 2020, the total number of civilians seeking safety in six Protection of Civilians (PoC) sites located on UNMISS bases is **187,942**. This includes 115,479 in Bentiu, 27,927 in Malakal, 29,696 in Juba UN House, 1,925 in Bor, and 12,915 in the area adjacent to UNMISS in Wau.
